D. Question: Can these limits be waived or modified to meet the state of Georgia required limits since it predominantly applied to asbestos, hazardous material, and waste disposal?

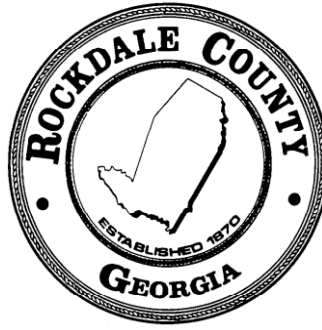
Answer: Yes. RDOT concurs. These insurance requirements due not apply to the nature of this work.

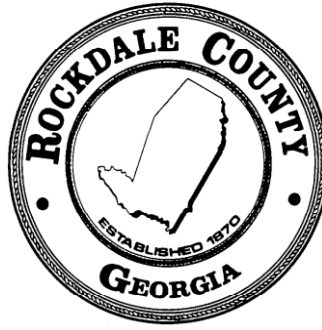
