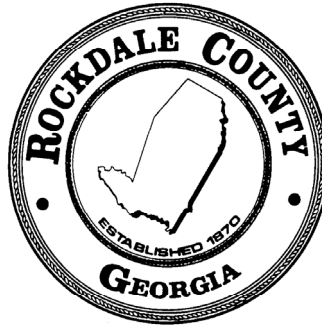

**RFQ No. 23-18
STORMWATER MASTER PLAN SERVICES FOR ROCKDALE COUNTY
DEPARTMENT OF STORMWATER MANAGEMENT**

August 17, 2023

RFQ #23-18 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Below are questions received and corresponding answers:

A. Question: Is there a page limit for the proposal?

Answer: No

B. Question: What is the extent of stormwater infrastructure included in the data inventory? The H&H modeling section specifies County to 12" and non-County needed for connectivity, but this distinction is not mentioned in the data collection task.

Answer: The extent of the stormwater infrastructure has the same distinction as the H&H. The following features shall be included in the collection effort, at a minimum:

- All open channels;
- All pipes 12" and larger in the tributary watershed network;
- All pipes downstream from an identified flooding concern;
- All structures (catch basins, control structures, drop inlets, flumes, headwalls, junction boxes, manholes, plain pipe ends, spillways, standpipes, trench drains, etc.) along drainage features meeting the above criteria.

C. Question: The County shared an online GIS application, but the analysis functionality is limited. As a result, is it possible to also share the underlying stormwater infrastructure GIS files?

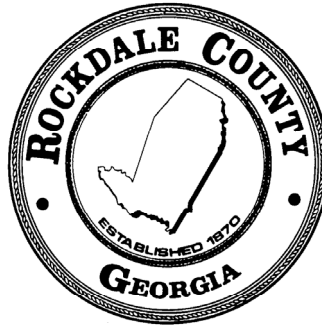
Answer: The underlying stormwater infrastructure GIS files will not be shared with analysis functionality.

D. Question: Can the County confirm that it wants CCTV for all stormwater infrastructure (p. 12 of RFP)?

Answer: Yes

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E. Question: How does the County envision using IWORQ? Will it be a part of the mobile data collection?

Answer: The County envisions using IWORQ as it's stormwater management operations and maintenance system. Currently, it's not part of the mobile data collection but the goal is to have it as part of the mobile data collection.

F. Question: Can the County confirm it wants sub catchments/model parameterization for every structure that receives flow (p.14 of RFP).

Answer: Yes, the model parameterization should include every structure that receives flow.

G. Question: The RFP indicates that modeled conveyance should extend to the confluence with FEMA floodplain (p. 14 of RFP). Can the County confirm it anticipates including stormwater infrastructure within the floodplain in the SWMM model?

Answer: Yes, the model should include all stormwater infrastructure including within the floodplain.

H. Question: Can the County provide an estimated structure quantity - number of inlets and pipes per watershed?

Answer: There are about 25,600 total structures in the county and about 15,650 total pipes.

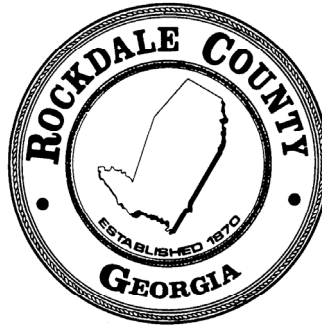

I. Question: Page 2 of the RFP indicates the selected consultant is expected to sign the County's standard contract. Can a copy of this contract be provided?

Answer: The contract is not complete at this time.

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J. Question: Page 22 of the RFP requests bonding capacity & value of work under contract. Please confirm this is not applicable to this project and no bonding is required.

Answer: This is not applicable for this project and no bonds are required.

K. Question: Page 28 of the RFP requires proof of a contractor license and GDOT prequalification. Please confirm these two elements are not applicable to this solicitation.

Answer: These two elements are not applicable.

L. Question: Regarding #12 on page 9 of the RFP - what exactly are you asking for in regard to warranty information? Or is this applicable to this pursuit?

Answer: Not applicable

M. Question: Regarding #12 on page 9 of the RFP - what information are you expecting regarding delivery time after receiving order? Or is this applicable to this pursuit?

Answer: Not applicable

N. Question: Do you want an assessment of streams as a part of this work, for instance, stream walks?

Answer: No

O. Question: Have you identified the areas of flooding concern and how many are there?

Answer: No

P. Question: For new residential and commercial developments, which portions of stormwater conveyance and treatment system are turned over to the county vs remain under private ownership?

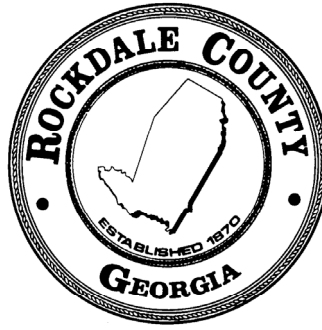
Answer: All infrastructure in the County's Right of Way is the County's responsibility and all other is private ownership.

Q. Question: Are you going to be looking for a calibrated or validated H&H model? Do you have any high-water marks and/or surveyed peak stages during flood events? Do you have any stream gauging stations?

Answer: Yes, the H&H model should be calibrated or validated. The County currently does not have any data on high water marks or surveyed peak stages. The county has seven USGS stream gauging stations.

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R. Question: In light of questions being due on the 17th and the proposal due a week later, would you consider an extension to the proposal due date to digest the answers to our questions and how they may affect how we respond to the RFP?

Answer: Yes

S. Question: Can Rockdale confirm that the Information Technology Disclosures on page 3 of the RFQ are focused on potential County expenditures associated with this project?

Answer: Yes

T. Question: What quantity of stormwater conveyance assets are expected to be surveyed and assessed?

Answer: 100%

U. Question: What quantity of stormwater structures are expected to be surveyed and assessed?

Answer: 100%

V. Question: What quantity of stormwater BMPs are expected to be surveyed and assessed?

Answer: 100%

W. Question: Recognizing that it is the consultant's job to manage the survey effort to minimize the collection of unnecessary data for the model development, can the requirement to collect survey channel sections from top of bank to top of bank be removed if the consultant can demonstrate the terrain data is sufficiently detailed to not negatively impact the model results?

Answer: Yes

X. Question: Similarly, can it be assumed that the same survey requirements listed in Task 3 do not apply to headwalls, flared ends, and plain pipe ends and that inverts for pipe ends can be extracted from high-quality terrain data?

Answer: All structures must be surveyed following the survey requirements in Task 3.

Y. Question: Has Rockdale County created a County-wide impervious coverage GIS dataset?

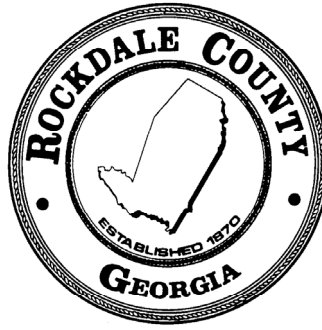
Answer: Yes

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Z. Question: Our firm Integrated Science & Engineering is interested in submitting on the “Stormwater Master Plan Services” RFQ for Rockdale County. We have a question about what software we can use for this project. We currently use a 500-node license for XP-STORM which is the same as XP-SWMM. It uses the EPS SWMM engine it is just XPs version. Can we use XP-STORM or do we have to use XP-SWMM as requested in the RFQ?

Answer: The required model is the USEPA SWMM.
