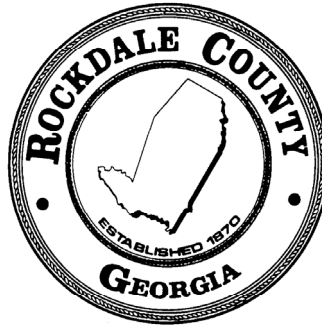

**ITB No. 24-26
ROCKDALE COUNTY LMIG & LRA RESURFACING PROGRAM**

April 7, 2025

ITB #24-26 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Below are questions received and corresponding answers:

A. Question: Will the County require the contractor to use an MTV (shuttle buggy) on this project?

Answer: Contractor shall use industry best management practices to ensure the quality of the delivered product to Rockdale County.

B. Question: Will the contractor be allowed to run the gate out for side road and driveway tie ins?

Answer: No issues taken at this time. County reserves the right to limit or eliminate any practices that are deemed an impediment to the community.

C. Question: Would the County consider extending the allowed lane closure hours from 8am to 5pm? Currently the allowed work hour window is only from 9am to 3pm, which is short and will cause slower production.

Answer: Hours are set to accommodate local traffic patterns. Slowed production is anticipated.

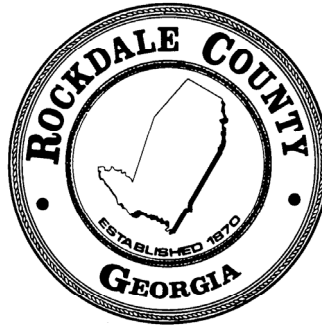
D. Question: Page 54 of the bid documents states that any salvageable millings shall be the property of Rockdale County DOT. Where should the contractor plan on hauling the millings generated from this project?

Answer: Rockdale County Department of Transportation

E. Question: Regarding the submission of hard copies, is it acceptable to provide one original and one copy, or are two original copies required?

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Answer: One original and one copy will suffice.

F. Question: Should the sample contract agreement and general conditions be included as part of the bid submission?

Answer: No

G. Question: If we do not intend to have a Sub-Subcontractor, is it still necessary to execute the affidavit as required for the bid proposal?

Answer: No

H. Question: Please provide insurance requirements for this bid.

Answer: See Addendum No. 1 attachment.

I. Question: Can you give a better detail on the GAB Patching Item that is line item # 15 on the bid schedule?

Answer: GAB will be used for base repairs in the patching process as needed.

J. Question: Is there any asphalt patching expected?

Answer: No asphalt patching is anticipated at this time.

K. Question: Where would the Remove/Replace Curb & Gutter be expected to go? One location or multiple locations?

Answer: Curb & Gutter will be removed and disposed of by the contractor.

L. Question: For the adjust shoulder to grade item, is that LM of shoulder or LM of roadway?

Answer: LM of roadway

M. Question: Will you accept Liquid Anti-Stripping Additive in place of H Lime per the attached GDOT Bulletin?

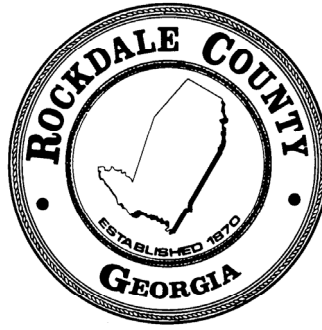
Answer: H-Lime is preferred
