**A RESOLUTION TO RESOLVE LOCALITY PAY UNDER THE SUPERIOR COURT
JUDICIAL COMPENSATION REFORM ACT.**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Rockdale County, Georgia, and the Rockdale Judicial Circuit Superior Court Judges are devoted to the protection of and justice for all citizens of Rockdale County; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court is a court of general jurisdiction, exercising original, exclusive jurisdiction, of all causes, both civil and criminal, including felony cases, except in the case of juvenile offenders; in cases respecting title to land; and in divorce actions. The Superior Court has concurrent jurisdiction with the state-wide business court and the Georgia Tax Court in equity cases, and exercises general supervision over all inferior tribunals.

WHEREAS, Superior Court Judges are compensated by the State of Georgia with additional compensation through a local county supplement pay in a manner as set forth by House Bill 85; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Rockdale County, Georgia recognizes the need to adjust budgetary implications to comply with Georgia law.

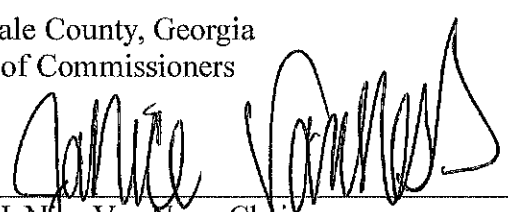
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and authorized by the Board of Commissioners of Rockdale County, Georgia, that the Superior Court Judges whom have opted into the salary structure outlined in House Bill 85 shall have their locality pay adjusted in 2026 to \$10,053, 5% of their base salary of \$201,060 and adjusted in 2027 to an amount not exceed \$20,106, 10% of their base salary and repeal any local resolution in conflict with House Bill 85.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this resolution shall become effective on January 01, 2026.

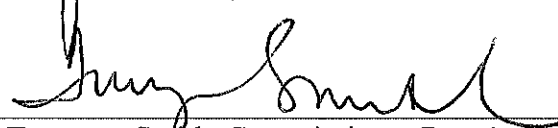

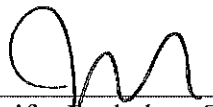

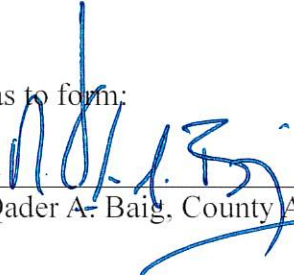
