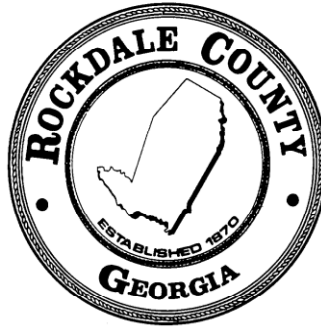

LOW VOLTAGE**

RFP #26-05 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Below are questions received and corresponding answers:

Hello,

I wanted to confirm my understanding of the requested proposal structure for the Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract for Low Voltage Construction Services.

Based on the solicitation language, it appears the County is seeking qualifications and pricing-based proposal structure for future as-needed low voltage projects, rather than pricing for one specifically defined project scope. My assumption is that the proposal would consist primarily of items such as:

A. Question: Labor categories and hourly rates

Answer: Yes.

B. Question: Material and subcontractor markups

Answer: Yes.

C. Question: Relevant qualifications and experience.

Answer: Yes.

D. Question: Certifications and available resources.

Answer: Yes.

E. Question: Response capabilities and support structure.

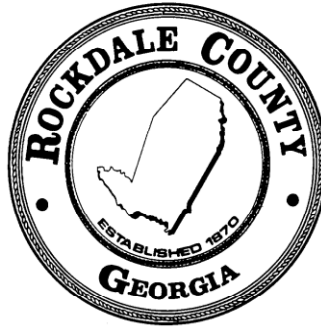
Answer: Yes.

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With individual project scopes and task orders to be issued separately as needs arise throughout the contract term. Could you please confirm if this is the intent of the solicitation, or if the County is expecting project-specific pricing or additional details beyond the items above?

If this is the type of support the County is currently seeking, to help us better understand the anticipated support environment and align the appropriate resources and manufacturer certifications, could you provide any information regarding the County's existing low voltage systems and platforms currently in use (access control, video surveillance, intercom, intrusion detection, structured cabling, etc.)? Understanding the current environment will help us determine the best approach to supporting future task orders under the contract.

Thank you again for your time and clarification.
